

Jean-Sebastien Sauriol on track this weekend at Spa Francorchamps

The driver from Saint-Sauveur, Jean-Sebastien Sauriol will take part in this weekend April 4-5 Fun Cup series round in Spa Francorchamps in Belgium. Invited by Hakim Ouassini of the Leader Racing team managed by Philippe Willems, Jean-Sebastien, will share the wheel of the 2 hours long race with French driver Hakim Ouassini.

« I can't wait to discover this magical track with its long, fast and elevated changes which is supposed to be one of the most beautiful tracks in the world. It is an interesting series with several endurance formats » says Jean-Sebastien who took part in a few rounds of the V de V endurance series in Europe in 2013 onboard a Mosler GT3 « It is always a challenge to both discover a new car and track at the same time. But who am I to complain because I am so fortunate to live such experiences and who never dreamed of racing in Spa! » says Jean-Sebastien Sauriol.

The Fun Cup series is extremely popular in Europe with starting grids of more than a 100 cars for the 25 hours of Spa event. The series is disputed on several fame circuits of the old continent with race duration between 2 to 25 hours long. The car weighs 750 kg and is powered by a 2 liters VW of 180 hp coupled with a sequential 5 speeds gearbox.
